OUR APPROACH

4 WALLS OF PROTECTION

FOOD: We can not effectively care for anyone unless their basic needs for food are met. The body needs food to survive and many times people come to the Mission in need of the most basic necessities.

SHELTER: A warm place to stay the night is essential for a healthy lifestyle. Our climate is harsh and many people will suffer frostbite or worse if unable to find a warm place to stay.

CLOTHING: Being equipped with appropriate clothing is crucial for survival. We provide lightly used, clean clothing to anyone in need to keep everyone safely protected from the extreme elements.

HEALTHCARE: We work closely with Southwest Montana Community Health Center to help facilitate healthcare providers on-site to give people easy access to the healthcare they need.

OUR CORE VALUES

Our Vision is to see lives transformed and filled with hope as our community works together to fight homelessness, poverty, and addiction.

Our Mission is to Partner with Southwest Montana to feed, clothe, shelter, and restore hope to those in need through the life-changing power of Jesus Christ.

We help anyone who is struggling with the trials of addiction, abuse, poor health, financial collapse, or any other problem that leads to homelessness the Butte Rescue Mission is here to help anyone in need get back on their feet through teaching and discipling.

RESTORATION PROGRAM

At the Butte Rescue Mission, we feed, clothe, and shelter the broken, impoverished, addicted, and forgotten. Our success here at the Butte Rescue Mission is based on taking a comprehensive and holistic approach. As we strive to support the emotional, psychological, and physical needs of the individual, we believe in nurturing their spiritual growth as well. Here, each person is taught that they have a natural belonging endowed to them only by their Creator. This is where real change takes place. The solution to all of the symptoms encountered here at the Butte Rescue Mission has been and will always be instilling hope that is rooted in the saving grace and the power of the Gospel. This is what separates our programs from all other outreaches in our community.

If the ultimate objective is to break the cycle of addiction and the things that hinder one's life, then the core tactics of lock-down, detox, education, support groups, and the like, are not enough. The key to complete recovery is a change of heart because if this does not occur, then the root of the problem(s) goes unaddressed and failure is much more likely. That is what we do at the Butte Rescue Mission. We help people so they can know that their future can be different. We offer services that enable them to choose a different life. We guide them from "Crisis" to "Restoration." There is a four-letter word for that process. The word is H-O-P-E.

This Restoration is what transforms formerly broken and dependent individuals into independent, responsible, and productive citizens.

RESTORATION PROGRAM: OUR PHILOSOPHY



RELATIONSHIP

Relationship is the foundational principle that each program at BRM is founded on. We believe that services alone can do little to effect change in people's lives. Rather, it is the personal connection between the BRM & its partners to those we serve that begins the restorative process



HOPE

Hope is fostered through these trusted relationships. Hope gives our guests, clients and residents the ability to dream and the faith to believe that a better future is possible.



EMPOWERMENT

Empowerment equips our guests, clients and residents with the resources necessary to lead more meaningful, settled and healthy lives.



TRANSFORMATION

Transformation becomes evident when positive change occurs in a person's life. Our job is to create program environments which best facilitate that systematic change.



RESTORATION

Restoration is the act of returning something to its created purpose that was lost, stolen or given away. It is the goal for every life we touch and results in thriving connections to people, to faith and to community.

Street Impact

IMPROVING THE ENVIRONMENT ON THE STREETS

Jim came to the Butte Rescue Mission through our low-barrier emergency shelter. Jim was given the opportunity to move into our program and chose to stay down at our emergency shelter for a bit longer to help care for another guest that is suffering from dementia. Finally, we were able to move both men into our program so Jim could continue to help keep an eye on him.

In the 2 months that Jim was here, he met another vet who was here and found out they served in Vietnam at the same location, they were both sergeants and never met until they arrived at our Mission. With Jim's help, the other vet was able to get to where he needed to go. Jim not only graduated but also was able to get a vehicle and housing while he stayed here.

This is a perfect example of why what we do is so important. We celebrate the potential in people who come to us in need. We put our words into action through the generosity of donors. We serve our community and the 10 surrounding counties. We believe all are worthy of love and compassion. It's our goal to lessen the impact of homelessness by not only taking care of the people who come to us for care but to be a good neighbor by making a difference in our city

452 unique individuals utilized a service at the Mission



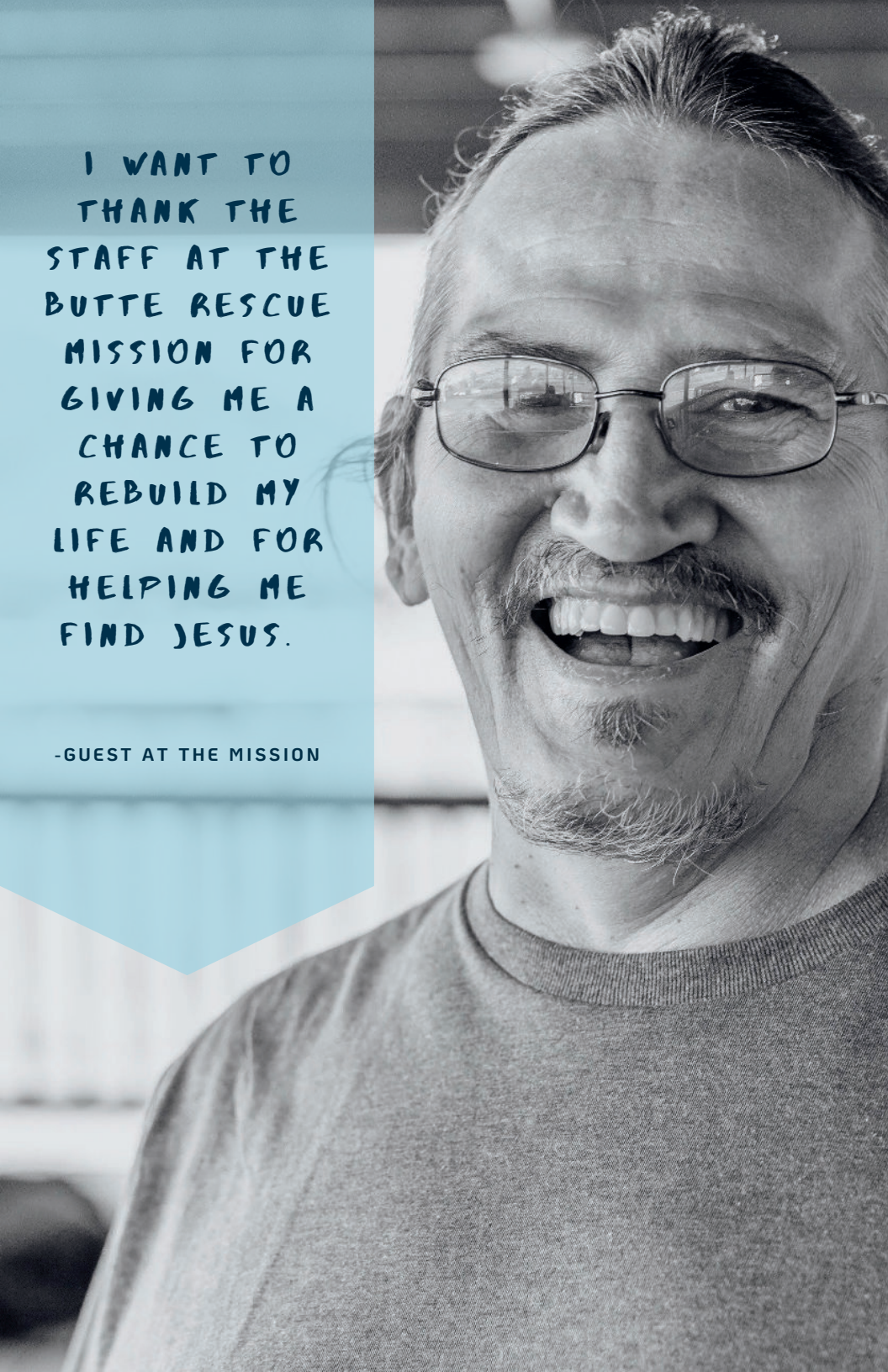
